Whereas, David Post of Buffalo County, Wisconsin

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at La Crosse, Wisconsin whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said David Post.

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for and the acts supplemental thereto for the north-west quarter of the north-east quarter of section one, in township twenty one, of range thirteen west, in the district of lands subject to sale at La Crosse, Wisconsin, containing forty-eight acres.

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL which said tract has been purchased by the said David Post

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said David Post

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said David Post and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Rutherford B. Hayes PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
